CIH Housing Academy is seeking to expand its pool of authors to reflect the increase in demand for online and blended learning qualifications and training.

The role involves following the processes and procedures set out in the CIH Guide to Authoring and other Housing Academy (HA) Policies and Procedures. This includes, as appropriate:

- a) Undertaking the development of online learning materials that are suitable for online learners accessing the CIH Virtual Learning Environment, Moodle
- b) Becoming proficient in Moodle to develop the learning materials for the unit agreed in the work assignment form
- c) Designing online learning materials using different formats and including a range of tools and activities to encourage learner engagement and interaction
- d) Developing formative and summative assessments in line with the requirements outlined in the work assignment form
- e) Submitting a short plan outlining the content to be included for each learning outcome/assessment criteria in each unit if required
- f) Developing materials that can be used across a range of situations including face to face and by a range of trainers and tutors
- g) Complying with copyright guidance and style guides.

- A supporting statement demonstrating how you meet the essential criteria outlined below. To support your application you should provide examples of any learning/training materials or assessments that you have produced
- Testimonials from two referees, preferably with at least one referee who can comment upon your experience of working in a learning and teaching/training setting (These should be supplied directly by the referee to CIH)

- be CIH members at or after appointment
- take out professional indemnity insurance
