Regional Networks has been rebranded and, as from our AGM on Saturday 1st June 2024, we are now **Tenants Together (Scotland).**

Tenants Together has a slightly different structure to Regional Networks but:-

- We will continue the good work of Regional Networks;
- We will continue to be run by and for tenants and service users of Social housing.
- We will still involve tenants and service users of registered tenant organisations (RTO's) and landlord-recognised groups.

Brief History of Regional Networks

- The Regional Networks were originally established in 2008 with nine regions.
- Restructured in 2017 with four regions
- The four regions covered the whole of Scotland. Each Network covered a number of local authority areas, and their membership was drawn from representatives of Registered Tenants Organisations (RTOs) and recognised landlord groups.



Key changes

- No longer divided into four separate regions
- No longer restricted to 2 or 3 members from each local authority area
- We now work as one national group of tenants
- Our Committee will be made up of our members to a maximum size of 32 and, for the first time, can include up to 5 individuals i.e. tenants and service users not part of an RTO or landlord-recognised group.
