The new Government

Labour's five missions to rebuild Britain

1) Kickstart economic growth

to secure the highest sustained growth in the G7 – with good jobs and productivity growth in every part of the country making everyone, not just a few, better off.

2) Make Britain a clean energy superpower

to cut bills, create jobs and deliver security with cheaper, zerocarbon electricity by 2030, accelerating to net zero.

3) Take back our streets

by halving serious violent crime and raising confidence in the police and criminal justice system to its highest levels.

4) Break down barriers to opportunity

by reforming our childcare and education systems, to make sure there is no class ceiling on the ambitions of young people in Britain.

5) Build an NHS fit for the future

that is there when people need it; with fewer lives lost to the biggest killers; in a fairer Britain, where everyone lives well for longer.


The Northern context

Key statistics

- Social housing providers contribute over £4bn/year to the North's economy & support over 70,000 jobs.
- Over 420,000 households on housing waiting lists.
- c. 12,500 children living in temporary accommodation.
- Enough brownfield land to build 320,000 homes.
- 365,000 northern PRS homes don't meet the decent homes standard (119,000 in the SRS).
- North's PRS tenants more likely to report poorer health.
- Lowest 20% of incomes are more likely to live in the North.
- Upgrading the energy efficiency of the North's homes could create 77,000
 new jobs.



Building the future



Our plan to work with the new government and our members to:

- Build new social homes and transform the North's communities – creating great places where people love to live.
- Create a new generation of green jobs in housing – getting the North's existing homes to net zero, making them warm, dry, and energy efficient.
- 3. Make sure everyone across the North has a good quality, safe home – upgrading social and private rented homes to help people create the lives they want in the places they call home.



Refocusing on regeneration

REFOCUSING ON REGENERATION

- 320,000 new homes on the North's Brownfield land
- A more flexible long-term Affordable Homes Programme focused on social housing, with a greater role for Combined Authorities
- Amend the Green Book appraisal guidance so that all projects are assessed using VfM categories rather than a single Benefit Cost Ratio calculation

- ☐ Government's ambition is promising and must be supported.

- More recognition required that the North is different to the rest of the country not just the need for New Towns, but a real need for 'renewed towns' and the return of a broader regeneration agenda.
- ☐ Funding is key, and funding needs to flow in a way that works for the North all eyes on the Spending Review.






