What is the Level 2 Award in Letting and Managing Residential Property?

The Level 2 Award in Letting and Managing Residential Property is a qualification suitable for residential private landlords, letting/managing agents and housing association staff letting and managing market-rented housing, in England.

Successful completion of this qualification will prepare you for the Level 3 Certificate in Letting and Managing Residential Property (England), which CIH also offers online.

Who can apply to study this qualification?

This qualification focuses on the housing industry in England and is suitable for:

- Individual landlords, letting one or a small portfolio of residential properties
- Letting and managing agents
- Housing association staff letting and/or managing market-rented properties
- Housing advice workers
- People not currently working in housing but considering a frontline housing position as a career option
